

# Crochet for Beginners:

## 1 Hour Class Outline

Crochet Class Outline for Mixed Ages Total Time: 60 Minutes

### Introduction (10 Minutes)

- Welcome and Introduction (2 minutes): Briefly introduce yourself and share your passion for crochet. Mention the objectives of the class.
- Overview of Crochet (3 minutes): Explain what crochet is and show some finished examples to inspire the class (e.g., scarves, hats, amigurumi).
- Crochet Materials (5 minutes): Present the basic tools needed (crochet hooks, yarn). Distribute materials to participants.

- Show and Tell (3 minutes): Allow anyone who wishes to share their work-in-progress with the group. Offer positive feedback and encouragement.

### Conclusion (5 Minutes)

- Wrap-Up (2 minutes): Summarize what was learned today and encourage participants to continue practicing at home.
- Further Resources (2 minutes): Provide information on where to find crochet patterns, online tutorials, and local yarn stores or craft groups.
- Q&A (1 minute): Open the floor for any final questions.

- Keep instructions simple and clear.
- Use visual aids and live demonstrations.
- Circulate and offer individual help.
- Foster a supportive, fun environment.
